# We need your help!

Many horses and horse owners have been devastated by the Queensland floods. To help them through these trying times Horseland has launched the Horseland Qld Flood Appeal.

Horseland has already donated essential products and hay to rescued horses in Toowoomba, Gatton and Ipswich.

But, there is still a huge demand for further assistance within the horse community. **How can you help?**

## New donated goods

Horseland stores will act as collection points for donated goods. These goods **must be new, within use-by dates and uncontaminated** to further protect the health of horses. Items can be purchased from any equestrian supplier.

### Products in high demand:

- Lite combo and standard rugs
- Canvas rugs
- Cotton rugs
- Mesh and airflow rugs
- Head collars
- Lead ropes
- Fly masks
- Cohesive bandages
- Betadine products
- Medicated shampoos and lotions
- Fly repellent
- Hoof ointment
- Grooming products
- Feed buckets

Goods will be distributed to the worst affected horses and horse owners through Horseland stores located in Toowoomba, Ipswich, Rockhampton, Bundaberg and Jindalee.

## Cash donations

Horseland is supporting Quest Equine Welfare's Flood Relief Appeal focused on sourcing and supplying feed, which is in urgent demand. They have sourced 6,000 hay bales to date and are delivering semi-loads of 800 bales regularly to affected areas.

Quest is a not-for-profit, 100% volunteer run organisation dedicated to assisting equines in need.
